MUSCADET FROM THE MASTER, MARC OLLIVIER

The first vintage of Domaine de la Pépière was in 1985. In the intervening years Marc has become a standard bearer for naturally grown and made Muscadet, as well as producing site specific wines. Along with other producers like Jo Landron, André-Michel Brégeon, Guy Bossard, and the Luneau family to name a few, he has shown that Muscadet is serious and age worthy. (While all these wines are tasty today, we admit they will only improve over the next few years). Farming is organic, harvesting is by hand, indigenous fermentations in tank, followed by aging in vat on the lees, minimal sulphur.

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CHABLIS

“I don’t like white Burgundy, but Chablis is Chablis, I like that.”
A friend and wine importer recently stated. Whether you roll your eyes at that or agree, Chablis’ uniqueness and specificity are undeniable. Lovers of Chablis rejoice in finding one that is truly titular - that could be nothing else.

Chablis is technically part of Burgundy, but the eponymous town is 85 miles NW of Dijon, the largest town of the Côte d’Or. The unique mix of the soil in each vineyard - how much chalky limestone to clay and fossilized seashells - and subtle differences in exposition are what makes each of Chablis vineyards’ wines so distinct from the next. The wines that follow are all chardonnay.... all Chablis.

BLANCOS GALICANOS
(WHITE WINES FROM GALICA)

Galicia is not the Spain of common imagination with warm dusty plains. Tucked in the northwestern corner of the country, it's lush and green; reminiscent of Ireland rather than Iberia. Galicia's cool maritime climate, inland river valleys, diverse geology, and focus on indigenous grapes makes it one of Spain's most interesting regions for wine, especially whites. Wines tend to be acid-driven and mineral forward with a clear sense of Terroir.

Rías Baixas is the most maritime influenced D.O. of Galicia. The sea can be seen from many vineyards, and perhaps it is suggestion, but a briny minerality is a calling card of these wines. After all 'Rías Baixas' mean 'lower fjords' in the local dialect. While other grapes are permitted in Rías Baixas, Albariño is king. The Salnes subzone, where these 2 wines come from, is unique for its sandy soils made up of decomposed granite.

Ribeiro is located further inland. It is influenced less by the ocean and more by the river valleys that form it. The best vines grow in the granitic soils high up on the hillsides where cool air refreshes the growing grapes. Treixadura is the main grape here - a grape that is about texture and subtlety - and other grapes are often blended with it. All 3 wineries represented here are owned by dedicated native sons trying to show the area's potential to the world. These are contemplative wines.

Ribeira Sacra is the largest D.O. of Galicia with 5 distinct sub-zones. It is a rugged region with steep terraced vineyards and a long history of grape growing. Menica (Red) is the most planted, but whites are grown as well, in the case of these wines, they are made from old vines reinvigorated by talented wine-growers.

Valdresorras is at Galicia's eastern edge - the furthest from the ocean. While lots of grapes are grown on the plains, the best wines come from the hillsides above the Sil river where the elevation and river influence cools the vineyards. Both of the wines below are made with Godello. The first on slate based soils, the second on granite based soils.

IN BETWEEN WINES

Rosé and orange wines live in the middle - they aren't quite red or white - so that's where we put them.

Rosé comes from red grapes and incorporates some of the color from the skin, but not enough to qualify as a red wine. Orange wines, also known as skin-contact wines, are simply wines made by leaving the grape skin in contact with the juice from white grapes. The flavor profiles are in a league all of their own displaying structure, tannin and texture. Orange wine may just spark a new fire in your wine game. Ya welcome.

BANDOL FROM CHÂTEAU DE PIBARNON

Bandol sits above the Mediterranean coast in Provence. Here the Mourvèdre grape is the dominant red varietal. It is uniquely suited to this spot. The grape retains freshness through the long Mediterranean summer, but it also needs a long time on the vine for its flavors to mature. The hillside vineyards and Mediterranean breezes allow for that long ripening. The red wines from here are curious in their ability to show power and earth, but retain a fresh quality. Pibarnon is an estate that exemplifies this. It's vineyards are at the highest altitude in the appellation within a natural amphitheatre. Its soils are unique as well. There is a high percentage of limestone as well as fossilized material not found in its neighbors' vineyard. Vines are cared for according to organic principles, harvest is always by hand, and wines are fermented with indigenous yeasts. The Bandol Rouge includes 10% Grenache and ages for 20 months in old large barrels. Dark fruit, spice, herbs, earth...it's all there.

PINOT NOIR FROM PORTER CREEK VINEYARDS

In 1977 George Davis purchased 40 acres of land in Sonoma to grow Pinot and Chardonnay. Twenty years later his son Alex took over. In addition to growing up working at the winery Alex spent several years in France working with renowned winemakers including Christophe Roumier. George and Alex have always focused on making delicate and elegant wines that show little oak and lots of *terroir*. Fiona Hill is a steep south facing hillside of clay over bedrock that pushes the vines to go deep. All farming is biodynamic. These are soulful expressions of Pinot, and it's surprising that they are not more well known.

SYRAH FROM COWHORN VINEYARD AND GARDEN APPLEGATE VALLEY, OR

Barabra and Bill Steele established Cowhorn in 2003. More than just a biodynamic vineyard, the estate is a polyculture farm where wine is just one product. The vines are planted at 2600 vines per acre, very dense, which encourages competition for water, nutrients, and sun. This makes for small production and high quality. Their focus is on Rhône grapes. In their words; "While our latitude is a bit lower than the Rhône, and our growing season is shorter, other qualities are similar, especially to Châteauneuf-du-Pape: river-side bench-land with little rain, hot summers, and rocky soils that don't hold much water."

We love what they do with Syrah (the bedrock here is granite). Fuller expressions of the grape that maintain balance. Each red is named with a number. The numbers are the hours of frost - when the mercury dipped below 32 - during the growing season (April through October). More hours of frost does not necessarily correlate to a cooler overall season though.
